



## WEEKLY PRAYER POINTS

### Sunday 1 (Focus on Reconciliation & Justice)

*Therefore, if you are presenting your offering at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your offering there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and present your offering. – Matthew 5:23-24*

This week we will confess **relational** sins: gossip, division, envy, slander, violence, arrogance, marital discord, disrespect, unforgiveness, etc. Confess your own sins as well as the sins of the Church and of America, then proceed to the following Prayer Points.

- 1) That those of us in the Body of Christ would better understand and fulfill our roles as torchbearers for Christ and ministers of reconciliation.
- 2) That America would replace division, incivility and hatred with respect, humility and love, and that our society would seek out and embrace God's truth and righteousness over political correctness.
- 3) That God would bring racial reconciliation to America, and that we would come together with open hearts and minds to discuss injustice, oppression, prejudice and hate.
- 4) That those who co-opt peaceful protests in order to steal, kill and destroy would not only be apprehended and held accountable for their actions, but that they might also find deliverance and forgiveness in Jesus Christ.
- 5) For our Judiciary, from local judges to the Supreme Court, that they would be granted godly wisdom and divine protection, and that they would render fair and impartial decisions.
- 6) That the nomination hearings for Amy Coney Barrett would be marked by grace and respect, and that God's will would be accomplished through this process.
- 7) For civility, integrity and statesmanship in the halls of government, and that righteous men and women would prevail in the coming election.

*Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation. – 2 Cor 5:18-19*
